



## SAVING THE REPUBLIC FOR WHICH WE STAND: Election Validity Framework

- **Election officials have been notified, and they remain MIA—whether this is malice, ignorance, or apathy, it does not matter, it has to be stopped.**

In other words, our public officials are attempting to defend our current election system with plausible statements of integrity but these supposed statements of fact are, in actuality, a self-serving illusion designed to mislead the public.

### CONCLUSION: This is a National Security Emergency.

People need to be fired, perhaps imprisoned. We have to stop using systems that cannot prove the voters who voted are legitimate, cannot prove all votes that were submitted legally were counted, and cannot prove that the counts were accurate.

**We recommend a simple plan to return to universally safe, transparent, honest and fair elections in our country:**

#### **Stop the Damage Immediately:**

1. Pause the use of electronic systems to tabulate and count the ballots and return to hand-marked paper ballots to guarantee accuracy and auditability of counts.
2. Outlaw all ballot harvesting and unexcused mail-in voting except by medical necessity to guarantee authenticity and that votes go from the voter's hands to the secured ballot boxes.

#### **Assess the Situation:**

3. Audit the voter rolls in every state, suspending registrations that cannot be verified in Federal databases. Individuals with unverifiable registrations will be contacted and allowed to vote if they can provide evidence of identity, citizenship and eligibility before or during the vote. This should be done at least 30 days before the elections.

#### **Repair the Process:**

4. Require Voter ID that verifies identity, citizenship and eligibility.
5. Study and recommend a method for improving voting access by the homeless and individuals with disabilities.



6. Each State must build and maintain an immutable data system to function as a continuous, permanent timeline of the election, utilizing an environment where records are never overwritten or deleted and every change is saved.

**Secure the System:**

7. Require Federal Information Systems Modernization Act (FISMA) certification of all systems including networks, computers, software, procedures, paper records, and policies starting with an independent Risk Management Framework (RMF) analysis with public hearings before any electronic system can be used again.
8. Use a system of Zero Trust Certificates to protect all data, software and machine configurations from tampering with real time checks.
9. Require all states to implement Sarbanes-Oxley compliant auditing standards on all aspects of election related systems, record keeping, and dependencies, including paper, ballots, counts, voter history, system data, and software.

**Allow Transparency to Build Trust:**

10. Require public access to voter registration rolls and voter history at no cost.

**Enforce Accountability for Breaking the Law:**

11. Implement clear criminal statutes for non-compliance with Federal Election and Civil Rights law.
12. Allow all citizens with knowledge of election mistakes and violations of law to have standing in Federal Court to sue over their concerns about violations and misconduct.
13. Change election law to:
  - grant standing to citizen groups and local governments to challenge non-compliant elections directly affecting them, and
  - grant national standing to states and citizen groups to challenge other entities and states that are disenfranchising or diluting the vote of their members or volunteers.
